When Tran Xuan Hoa was 11 years old, he had to drop out of school due to the extreme poverty of his family. His parents regretfully allowed him to go to Hanoi in order to find work. He lived on the streets until he found a shelter, which was operated by Samaritan's Purse.

There he received a shoebox gift. When he opened the box, he was surprised to find a flute. Who would have guessed that he knew how to play it!
