The area smells of trash and cow dung at the big garbage dump outside of Manila. No one wants to visit this area. Visitors hold handkerchiefs over their noses to block the smell.

Yet, there are people who work and live there. These people are low class Filipinos. They collect bottles and pieces of trash to sell. Their houses sit on the edge of the dump site and are made of trash.

The children in the area are quiet but happy. Boys run shirtless through patches of grass with a soccer ball. Girls watch and giggle in their crisp white school blouses and plaid skirts. The children have just finished a day of school.

Today is a special day and smiles are wide. The children have just received shoeboxes! Each child had special wishes.
