

When Azima received her shoebox, she found not only gifts, but a message from a 12-year old girl in America; "I don't know who you are, but Jesus loves you and so do I". In times of sorrow and grief when I needed to be reminded of God's love, I would clutch my shoebox close to my chest and pray. I had to hide the gift from my father because he discouraged us from going to church.

Religious superstitions greatly influenced peoples' lives in Cameroon and my father felt that bad things would happen to us. My aunt moved in with us when I was 9 years old. She would tell us about Jesus. When I was 14, she quietly took me and my sisters out of the house and took us to church without telling our father. The more we learned about Jesus, the more we wanted to know. I dedicated myself to teaching the children in my church how much God loves them. Several years later my father came to know the Lord.

I want to thank everyone who is part of Operation Christmas Child. God is using you to reach out to not just one child but to an entire family like mine. The power of one Shoebox is that God used it to change our lives.
