Each box is treated as a precious gift. All of the items that you include in your box remain intact unless they are on that list. Over 100,000 volunteers serve at 8 processing centers. After our shoebox gifts are blessed they will be taken to a drop-off location in Naples. There they are packed into large boxes and placed on to semi-trucks to be transported to a processing center in Atlanta. From there they will be flown by cargo planes to their designated country.
